## **Instructions for the Poster**

The students who will do the Erasmus experience at ANT in Bologna will have to create a poster that describe their experience. The posters will be printed in A0 format and exposed and explained during the conferences (Multiplier Events).

All the posters will be submitted by the students to a commission of ANT experts who will evaluate the most significant one.

During the final conference (Multiplier Event), which will take place in Padua, the best poster will be awarded by assigning the students of the group a prize to emphasize how important their work has been in capturing the themes of death education and palliative care.

All the students of each group or a student representative of each group will also participate via video-conference; all the works will be presented in an exhibition during the conference. The best poster will then be awarded by assigning the students representative of the group a prize to emphasize how important their work has been in capturing the themes of death education and palliative care.

The instructions for the creation of the poster are:

- Use the specially created template
- Use English for content writing
- Insert a title created by the students of the group at the top of the page
- Insert the following subtitle under the title: " Erasmus+ Project Death Education for Palliative Psychology DE4PP "
- The poster must contain the following contents:
  - A written report of their experience in Bologna with ANT, both at a descriptive level of the activities done with references to the contents of the course and at a personal level with the emotions felt during this experience.
  - The most 5 relevant photographs (one per person) taken during the ANT experience with a specifically created caption
  - The names of all group members and their University of affiliation.
    ATTENTION: when the poster will be submitted, these personal details must be obscured/removed in order to maintain anonymity, important for a correct selection of the winning poster.
  - Feel free to organize the contents of the poster as you wish, giving free rein to your creativity
