Abstract

This presentation will address the idea of J. L. Moreno of social death. Social atom is considered as the smallest social unit with people we have a relationship feeling with attractions and rejections. The interpersonal relationships may be dead or alive, real or in fantasy but are essential to the client's daily living. If someone dies, the before and after social atoms will look different. It is not always possible to substitute him or her - you will loose a part of yourself. A genosociogram uses a transgenerational perspective on this.

Included in the discussion are: a brief review of the history of sociometry and the social atom inventory, a sample questionnaire, clinical case examples and guidelines as well as precautions for clinical application.

Psychodrama

- Psychodrama = action and its exploration, process of learning by experiencing (Blatner, 2019)
- Method of psychotherapy, counseling, education and social research
- Developed by Doctor Jacob Levy Moreno (1889-1974) in Vienna and New York

Social Atom

- Smallest social unit (its representation in the mind of the client)
- Emotional relationships with attraction and rejection
- Interpersonal relationships can be "warm" or "cold", real or imaginary; these are essential for the daily life of the client
- Living and dead persons can be represented





Social Atom

Brief review of the history of sociometry:


- originally began as a therapeutic science
- grew into a general science of the group

Goals:

 \rightarrow research into the composition of the group; the selection of patients suitable for treatment

→ to find the syndromes that are characteristic for the group and methods to treat groups and individuals successfully


(Original figure: 1936 Sociometric Review 1)





Social Atom

- Social atom inventory: family of origin, present-day, future projection, parent-child atom (Dayton, 2005)

 - safe place/inner helpers (Stadler, 2014, pp. 58-65).






Social Atom and Death

- When someone dies, the social atom before and after looks different (social death)
- It is not always possible to replace the person who passed away, you lose a part of yourself and need "death catharsis" (Moreno, 1947, p. 83)
- Genosociogram → transgenerational perspective

(s. figure Ancelin-Schützenberger, orig. Vouloir Guérir, 1985)






Social Atom and Death

- Clinical case examples Bring flowers to a "non existing" grave in Auschwitz, accepting that the brother is not alive any more (Abraham, 1972, pp. 88-90); The confrontation; The Judgement; The Rebirth (Siroka & Schloss,1968, pp. 203-205)
- Guidelines and precautions for clinical application:

→ "What would you like to change?"

→ Informed consent of the client


